BLET SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

THE CITY OF GOLDSBORO IS NOW OFFERING AT LEAST TWO (2) SCHOLARSHIPS, UP TO A MAXIMUM OF \$5000, TO GOLDSBORO OR WAYNE COUNTY RESIDENTS WHO DEMONSTRATE A FINANCIAL NEED. A MONTHLY STIPEND WILL ALSO BE AWARDED, NOT TO EXCEED \$5000, OVER THE DURATION OF THE PROGRAM.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

All applications for scholarships must be accompanied by required documentation, which is included in the application package. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Applications can be obtained from Ms. Beverly Deans at Wayne Community College, the executive assistant at the City of Goldsboro's Police Department, or the City of Goldsboro's website page (Human Resources) at www.goldsboronc.gov. A copy of the application form and instructions can be obtained from either of these locations or downloaded from the City's website.

- Applicants must be a resident of Goldsboro or Wayne County.
- Applicants must be in pursuit of a career in law enforcement with the City of Goldsboro.
- Applicants must be registered to attend Wayne Community College's Basic Law Enforcement Training Academy, which begins January 7, 2019.



APPLICATION DEADLINE IS DECEMBER 28, 2018
Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than JANUARY 4, 2019.
