PLEASE EMPTY OUT ALL FOOD AND LIQUIDS



Plastic #1 and #2 cleaning bottles and containers
(put pumps in the trash)



Plastic #1 and #2 food and beverage tubs, jugs and bottles
(keep lids and caps screwed on)



Plastic #1 and #2 bathroom bottles
(put pumps in the trash)



Aluminum, tin, steel cans
(quick rinse)



Mixed paper, office paper, glossy paper, envelopes and Post-It notes



Newspapers, magazines, phonebooks and catalogs



Paper towel rolls, paper bags, **flattened** food boxes, paperboard and cardboard
(clear of food and food stains only)
