

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
FOR THE GOLDSBORO URBAN AREA METROPOLITAN
PLANNING WORK PROGRAM**

Notice is hereby given that the Draft Planning Work Program for Fiscal Year 2022 of the Goldsboro Metropolitan Planning Organization has been released for a 30-day public comment period.

The 2021-2022 Draft Planning Work Program (PWP) outlines the tasks and associated funding sources to include activities that will permit the City of Goldsboro, the Village of Walnut Creek, Town of Pikeville, Wayne County and the North Carolina Department of Transportation to continue transportation planning for the Goldsboro Urban Area.

The goal of the Goldsboro MPO is to ensure a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive approach for transportation planning for the metropolitan area, both short and long-range. Depending on the specific funding source, tasks funded through the PWP are eligible for reimbursement of 80-90% of their cost from the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration through the North Carolina Department of Transportation.
