ARTICLE VIII. SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Two (2) education scholarships will be awarded. They will be for \$500.00 each. The following criteria will apply for the scholarships:

1. Graduating senior.
2. Maintain a minimum of a 3.5-Weighted GPA.
3. Submit application to advisor with a copy of your transcripts
4. Submit letter of acceptance from the college attending.
5. Submit two letters of recommendation from school counselors, academic teachers and/or principal.
6. Meet all council requirements (Attend 12 meetings, participate in 1 committee meeting, participate in 7 service projects and the gift wrapping fundraiser).
7. Complete an interview with the judges. A date and time for your interview will be mailed to you.

All seniors are encouraged to apply for this scholarship! It is not based completely on council requirements.
