

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP AND COMMENT  
FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN (CTP) FOR THE  
WAYNE COUNTY/GOLDSBORO METROPOLITAN URBAN AREA**

Notice is hereby given that a public workshop and comment for the development of the Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) for the Wayne County/Goldsboro Metropolitan Urban Area has been scheduled.

Wayne County, the Goldsboro Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), the Eastern Carolina Rural Planning Organization (RPO), and the Transportation Planning Branch of the North Carolina Department of Transportation have actively worked to develop a comprehensive transportation plan (CTP) for the **Wayne County / Goldsboro Metropolitan Urban Area**.

A public workshop will be held from 4 to 7pm, on April 19, 2016 at City Hall Annex, 200 N. Center Street, Large Conference Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor to provide a draft comprehensive transportation plan(CTP) used to benefit future highway, public transportation, bicycle, and pedestrian travel in the Goldsboro MPO (which includes the City of Goldsboro and Town of Pikeville) and Wayne County (which includes the Towns of Mount Olive, Fremont, Seven Springs, and Eureka).

The purpose of this workshop is for NCDOT and local planning staff to provide information, answer questions, and receive public comments and input on the future long range plans for transportation in Wayne County.

The County, MPO, RPO, local municipalities, and the Department of Transportation are directed by North Carolina General Statutes 136-66.2 to reach agreement for a transportation system that will serve present and anticipated volumes of traffic in the County.
