North Carolina Litter Sweep: Sept. 16-30

- The 2023 Fall Litter Sweep will take place Sept. 16-30.
- Litter Sweep is the N.C. Department of Transportation's biannual statewide roadside litter removal initiative.
- Residents throughout the state participate in local efforts to help clean up North Carolina's roadways.
- In addition to volunteers, NCDOT maintenance crews devote one week of their time to pick up litter and collect orange bags placed on the roadsides by volunteer pickups.
- Volunteers are provided cleanup supplies, such as orange trash bags, gloves and orange safety vests, from their local NCDOT County Maintenance Yard office.

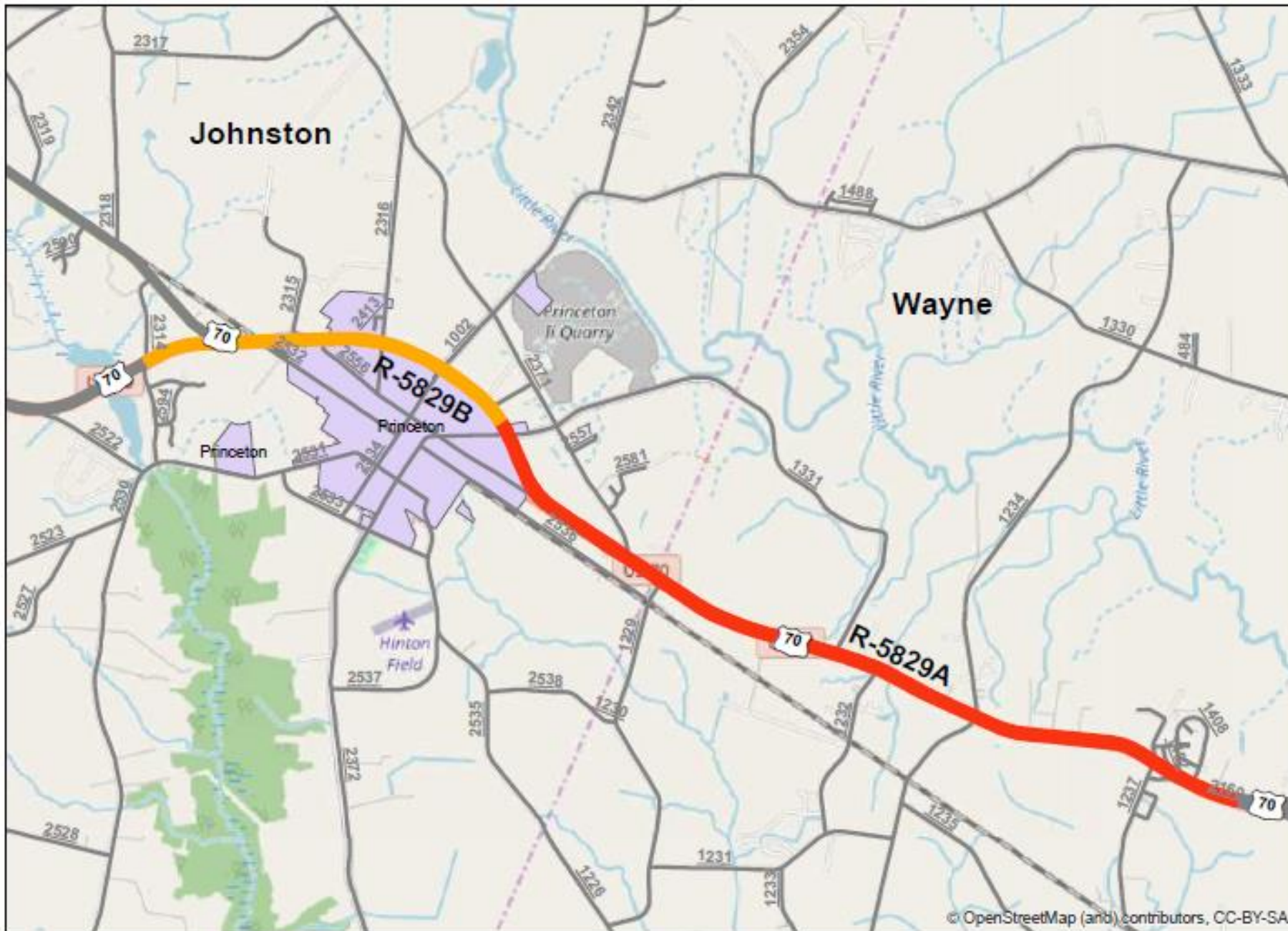

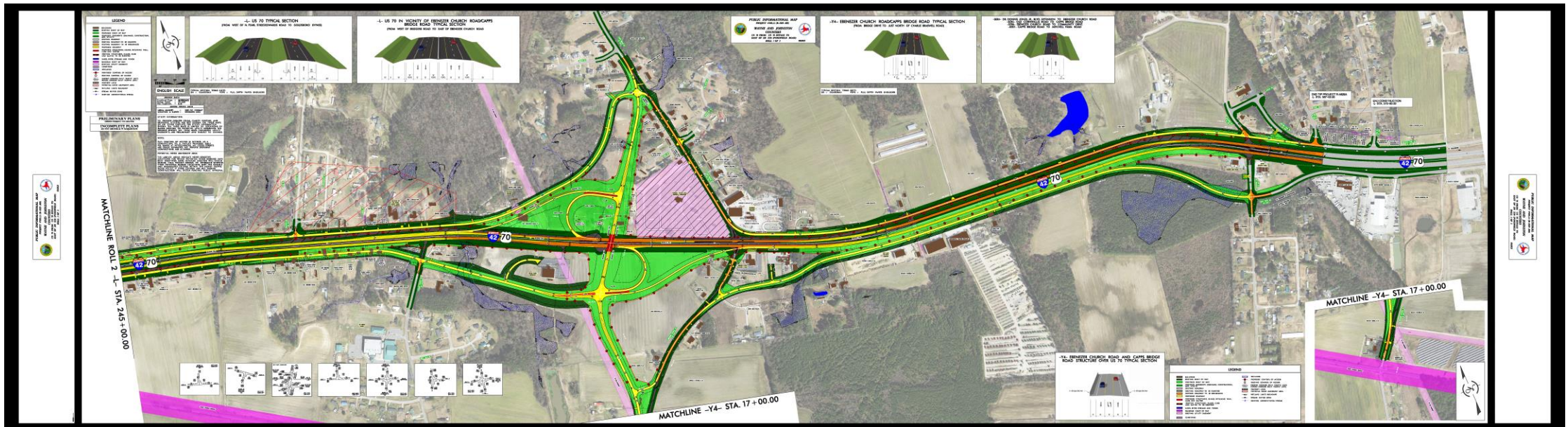

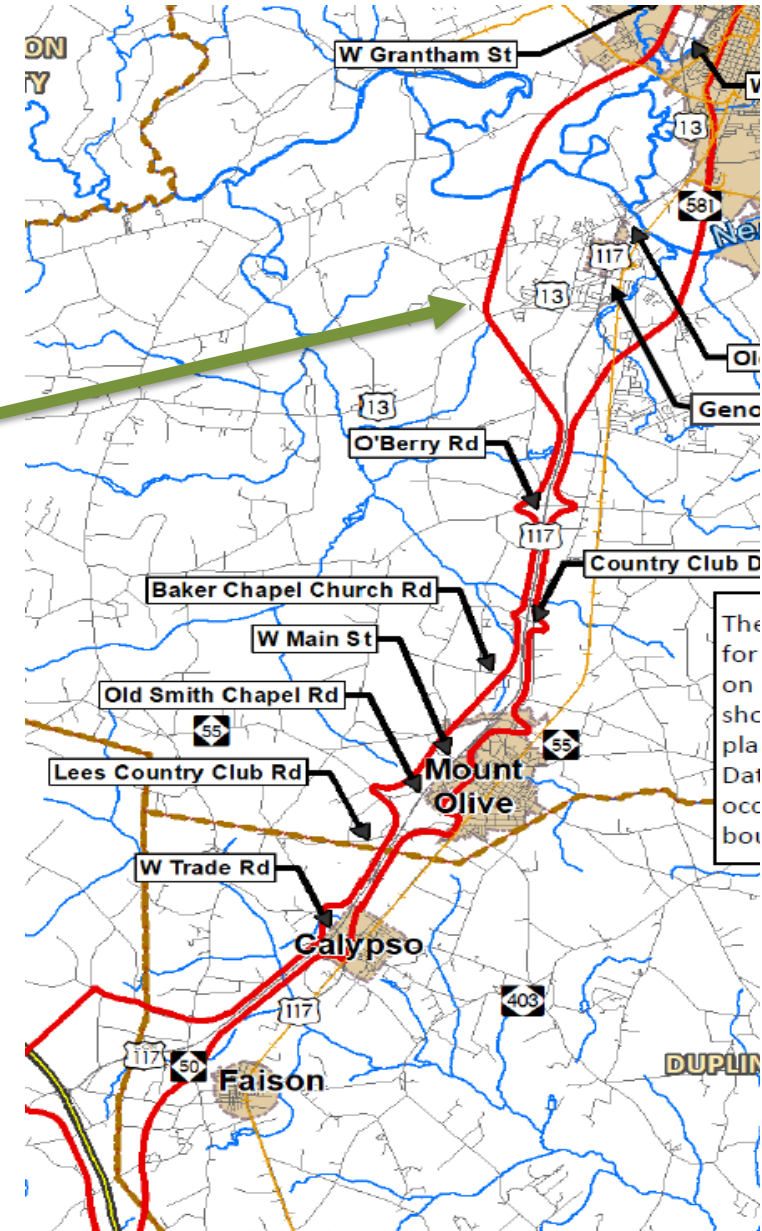

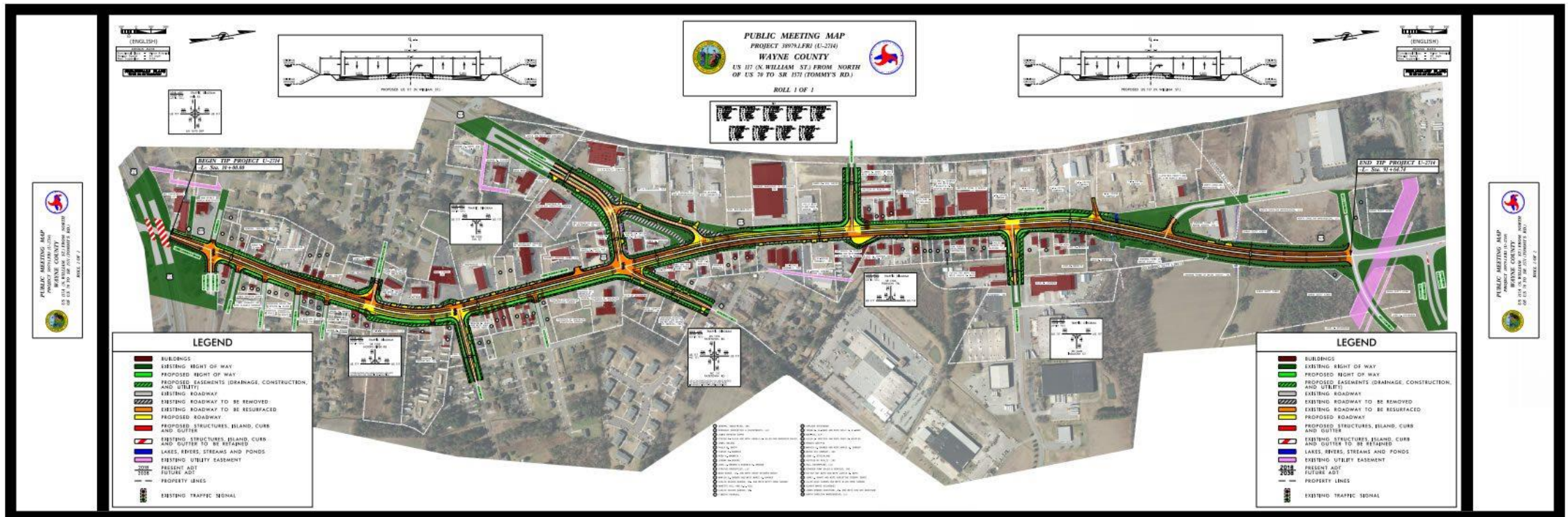

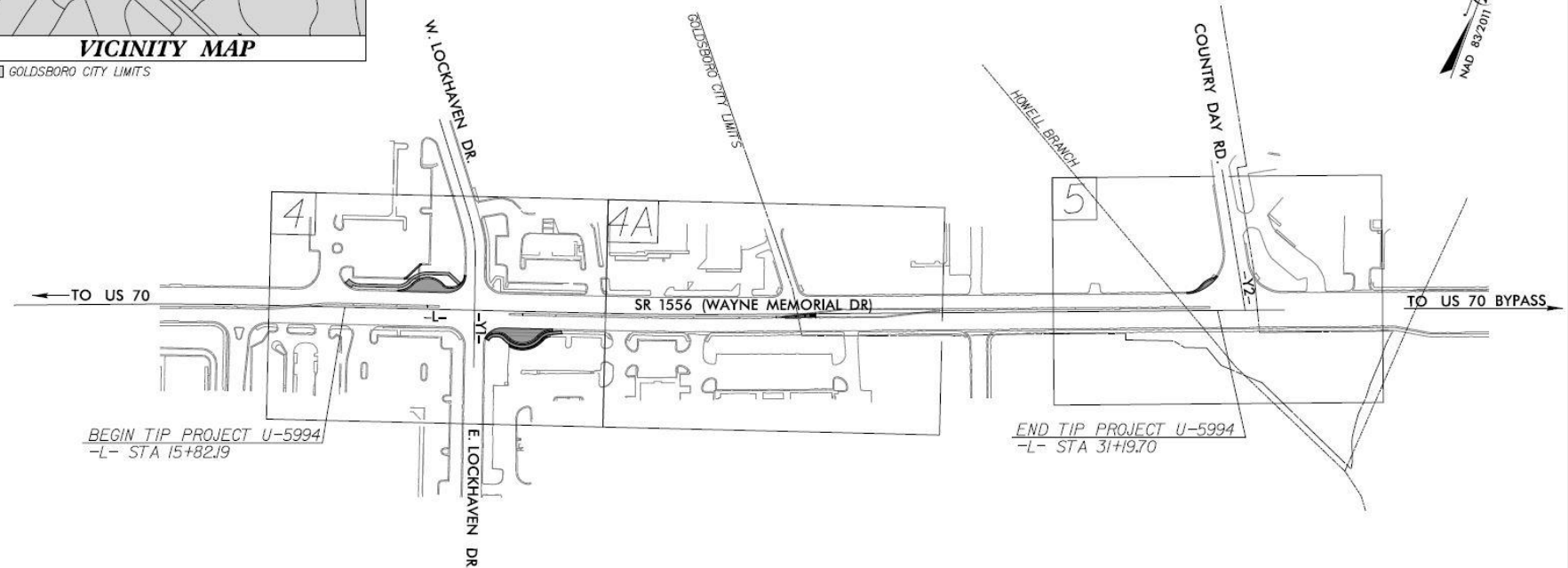

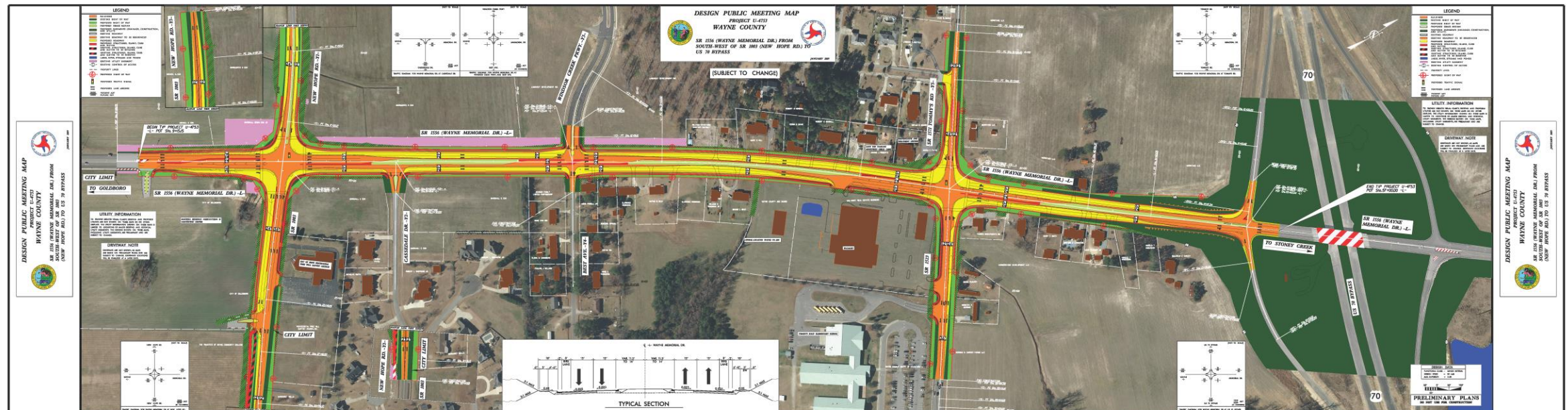

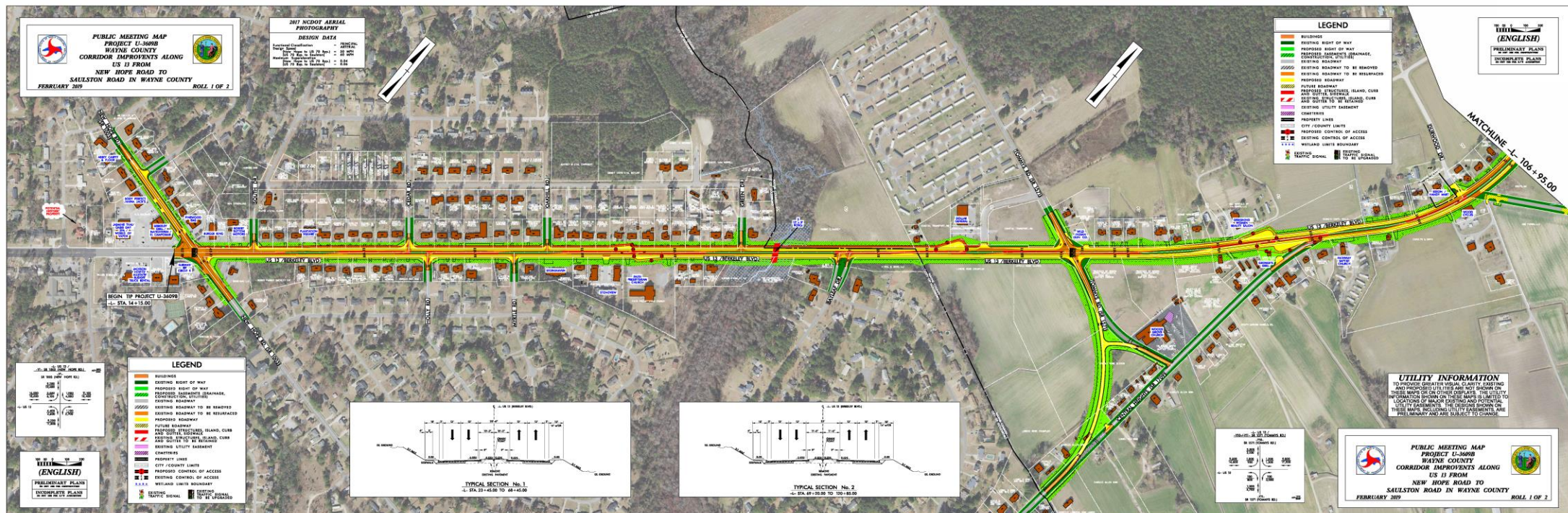
U-3609B – Widen & Improve US 13 (Berkeley Blvd.)

- U-6205 – Widen Wayne Memorial Dr. from US 70 Bypass To Stoney Creek Church Road.
- U-6206 – Modernize Miller's Chapel Rd. from US 70 to Thoroughfare Rd.
- U-6207 – Modernize Bill Lane Blvd. from Arrington Bridge Rd. to NC 111

Additional Programs

- Low Impact Bridge Replacements
- Resurfacing
 - 3 current contracts
 - \$9.2M
 - 67.04 miles of roadway improvements
 - Approximately 17% Complete overall
- Safety Projects, both state and federally funded
- Locally Administered Projects including sidewalks/greenways
